

COVID-19 Coronavirus: In-Kind Product Donations

UCLA Health also seeks in-kind donations of products to protect our front-line providers and the patients we care for. As these needs evolve during this unprecedented global healthcare crisis, the list below will be updated daily.

All donations must be **unused and unopened**, as they will need to be reviewed to meet infection control approval standards. **For your safety and the safety of our healthcare staff, we cannot accept any in-person drop-offs at any of our medical centers, emergency rooms, testing sites, or clinics.** Please note that we have opened a limited-hour UCLA Health COVID-19 PPE Collection Center in Van Nuys. See below for more information on hours, location, safety requirements, and directions for drop off.

PPE/Medical Product Needs with Recommended Minimum Donation

Disinfectant Clorox Sani-Cloth Wipes or Antibacterial Wipes (unopened)

- Minimum of 10 containers

Hand Sanitizer

- (Commercial brands with 62% or above ethyl alcohol; dye and fragrance free)
- Minimum of 500 unopened 1-ounce personal size/minimum of 25 unopened 8-ounce or above containers or pumps

N95 NIOSH-approved Respirator Masks

- Minimum of 10 unopened boxes of no less than 10 masks per box
- Preferred brands: Halyard; 3M models 1860/1860s/8210s; Kimberly Clark; Moldex. Submit alternate brand inquiry to COVID19PPESupport@mednet.ucla.edu only if you have large quantities
- **We can no longer accept KN95 masks.**

Surgical Masks (Must meet medical materials standards)

- Minimum of 10 unopened boxes with no less than 20 masks per box
- **We are unable to accept small quantities of handmade masks at this time. If you can immediately supply a minimum of 500, please contact COVID19PPESupport@mednet.ucla.edu**

Isolation or Surgical Gowns

- Hospital standard; minimum of 10 unopened cases with no less 50 gowns per case

Disposable Lab Coats (all sizes)

- Minimum of 10 unopened cases of 50 coats per case

Universal Viral Transport Swabs

- Minimum quantity 10 packs with no less than 50 swabs per pack

Non-Vented Goggles (unused and unopened)

- Minimum of 10 goggles per case pack

Disposable Non-Latex Gloves (all sizes)

- Minimum of 10 unopened boxes

Ventilators in Full Operational Mode

- Preferred model: Medtronic Puritan Bennett 980 Ventilator
- For other models submit inquiry to COVID19PPESupport@mednet.ucla.edu
