

Instructions for completing UCLA Health – Volunteer/SRP Health Clearance Requirement

1. Gather all of your Immunization Records and have ready for uploading.
2. Log in to the [Ashe Patient Portal](#) and click “Appointments”
3. Select “UCLA Health-Volunteer/SRP Health Clearance Requirement” and complete the form below:

Hepatitis B (volunteers are strongly recommended to be vaccinated/immune to Hepatitis B. It is not required for all volunteers.)

* Using the Add Attachment option, upload a copy of your Hepatitis B vaccines or complete the Hepatitis B Declaration form

* or request a blood test to screen for immunity

You will receive an auto-response that your form has been successfully submitted. Do not go to the lab until you have received a message indicating that your lab tests have been ordered.

Varicella titers can take up to 5 business days to come back. MMR and T-spot results are between 2-3 business days. You will be sent a secure message once your Clearance is complete. A Letter will be posted on the Patient Portal for you to turn into the UCLA Health Volunteer Office.
