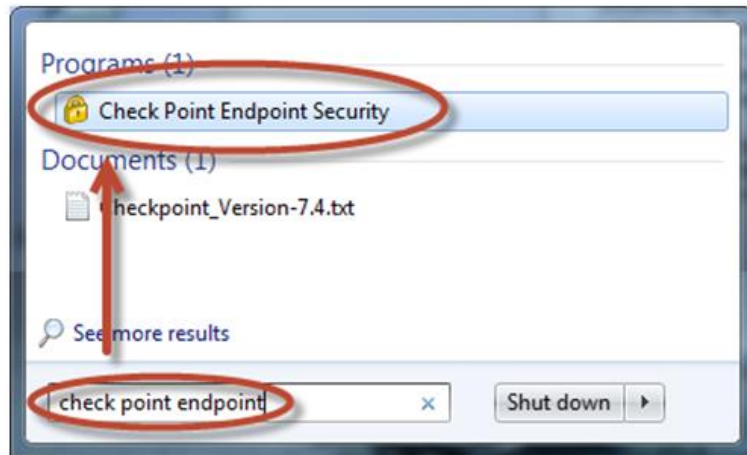


## How to check if your computer is encrypted with Check Point Endpoint Security

### Locate Check Point Endpoint Security

Click on the **Start Menu** button at the bottom-left corner of your screen and search for **check point**.

Click on the search result to **open**.



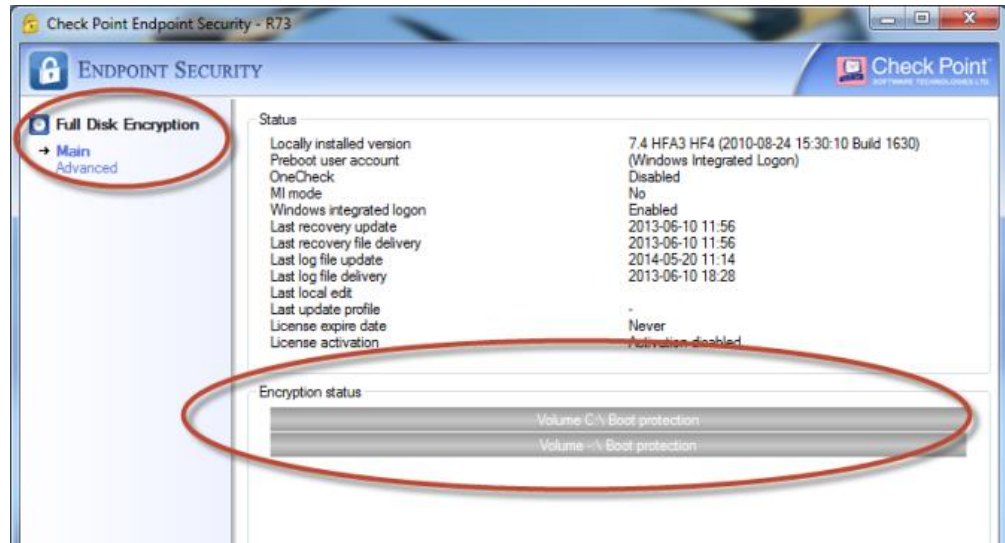
## Confirm Computer is Encrypted

Depending on which version of Check Point is installed, you will see one of the two windows.

### Older Version

On the left pane, select **Full Disk Encryption** and then **Main**.

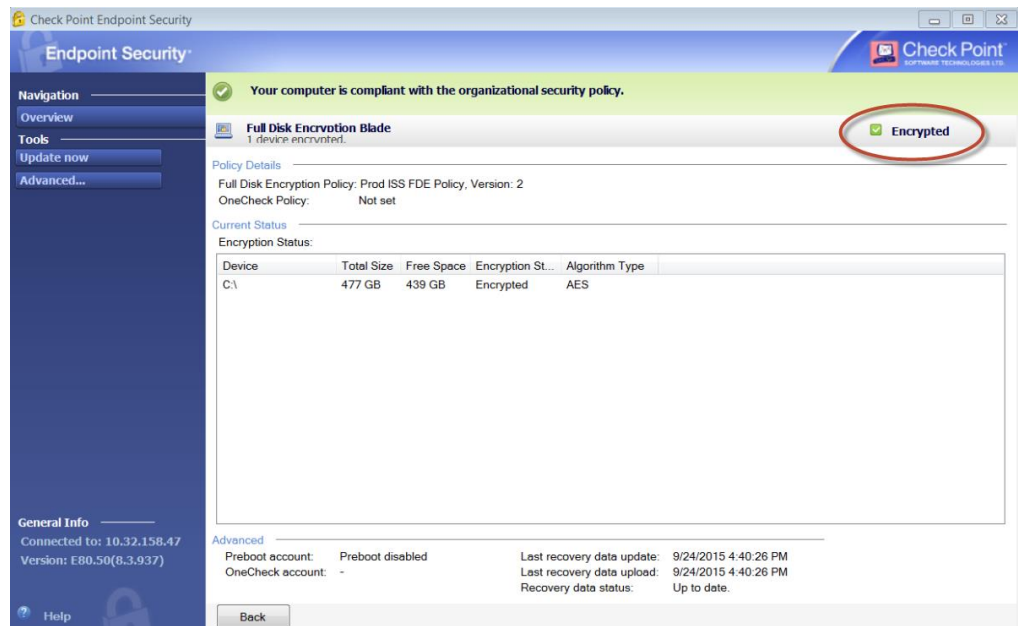
If you see **Boot protection** under **Encryption status**, your computer is encrypted.



### Newer Version

On the right, look for **Full Disk Encryption Blade**.

If you see a checkmark with a green box next to **Encrypted**, your computer is encrypted.
