

Information about the Live Online Format of TMF 2022

Due to the ongoing global health crisis, the TMF is being run in 2022 as a Live Online program. You will be expected to be present to participate in the live practicum sessions via Zoom, also called synchronous learning. Although sessions will be recorded for later reference, you must be able to participate synchronously.

1. How can I participate if I live in another time zone?

We have had students in the TMF from many different time zones. Since the multi-day practicum sessions are recorded, international students can attend as much as possible synchronously and then watch the recordings for the hours they have to miss. All other TMF events will be scheduled to accommodate multiple time zones.

2. What are the 2022 practicum dates and times?

January 27-30

April 28 - May 1

August 11-14

November 9-13 (5 days)

All Live Zoom Practicums will be held Thursday - Sunday, 9am-5pm Pacific Standard Time.

Note: The November Practicum will include Wednesday, 9am-5pm.

3. How well has the TMF worked on Zoom?

While there is no full substitute for in person connection, we have had significant success with utilizing the Zoom format to create community and creatively teach our material.

4. Will you shift to in person learning at some point through the year if the pandemic restrictions are lifted?

No, the 2022 TMF will be fully online regardless of health protocol changes.
