BMAT- Pediatrics

Recommended patient population: Patients age > 4 years of age with ability to follow directions Ensure activity order in place and safety screening clearance before assessing with BMAT

ASSESSMENT LEVEL 1

SIT AND SHAKE

From a semi-reclined position, ask your patient to sit upright and rotate to a seated position at the side of the bed.

Ask patient to reach across midline to shake your hand



STRETCH AND POINT

Ask patient to extend leg forward until it is straight at the knee.

Ask the patient to point and flex foot/toes. Repeat with other leg if appropriate.

ASSESSMENT LEVEL 3

STAND

Ask your patient to elevate off the bed or chair using an assistive







Patient should be able to raise buttocks off bed and hold for a count of five.

device if needed.

ASSESSMENT LEVEL 4

WALK

Ask your patient to march in place at bedside.

Then ask patient to advance step and return each foot.
