- Solid Tumor patients-pancreatic, breast, colon, gastric, sarcoma, prostate, bladder, colon, etc

  - Bone metastasis
  - Obstruction
  - Neuropathies
  - Anxiety
  - Fear
- ? Realistic expectation of pain relief.

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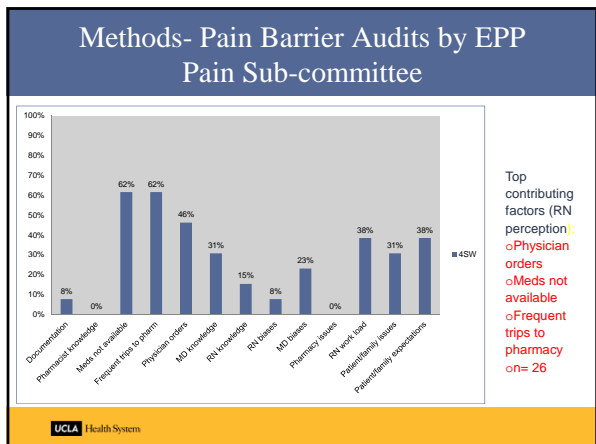
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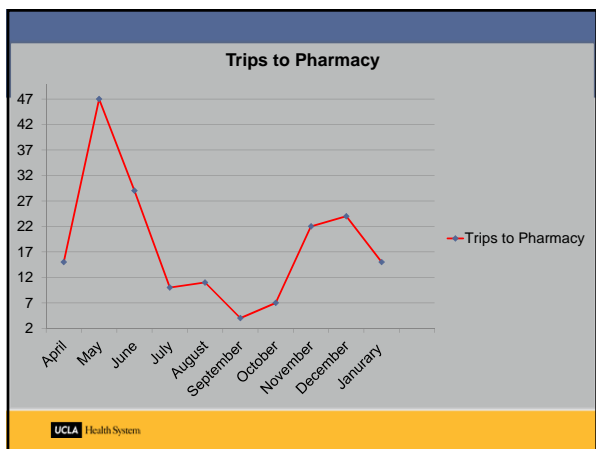
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- ### Interventions by Pain Champions
- A Pyxis drawer for liquid morphine- comes in multi-dose bottle and must be drawn up in individual doses
  - Continuing to work on solution with pharmacy
  - Tracking wait time in pharmacy
  - Discussions with Palliative Care for alternative pain medication but liquid pain medications are often the only choice
  - Staff Education with Simulation for RNs and CCPs
  - CCP Education- warm packs, repositioning, spa channel
  - Leadership Rounding 5x/week
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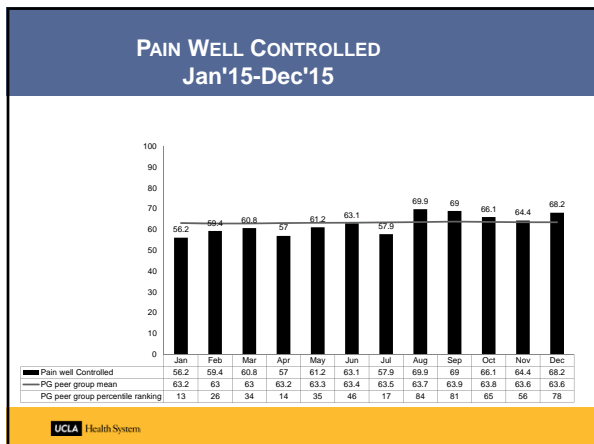
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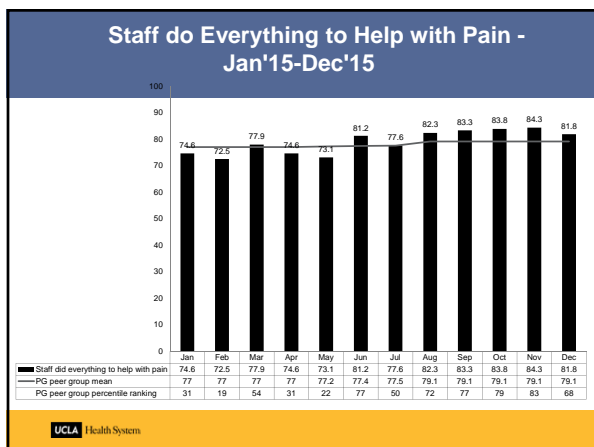
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### Conclusions
