Alta Charo (BA biology, Harvard '79; JD law, Columbia '82) is professor emerita of law and bioethics at the University of Wisconsin, and now works as a science policy consultant for a variety of government and industry entities. Both before and during her time in academe, she has worked at

the former congressional Office of Technology Assessment, the US Agency for International Development and the FDA. Her advisory committee service includes membership on the NIH Human Embryo Research Panel, President Clinton's National Bioethics Advisory Commission, the WHO expert committee on genome editing, and the International Society for Stem Cell Research guidelines drafting committee. She also co-chaired the National Academies' committee on embryonic stem cell research guidelines and the committee on governance of human genome editing. At present, she serves on the organizing committee for the 2023 Third International Summit on Human Genome Editing. Charo has been elected to the National Academy of Medicine, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the AAAS.
