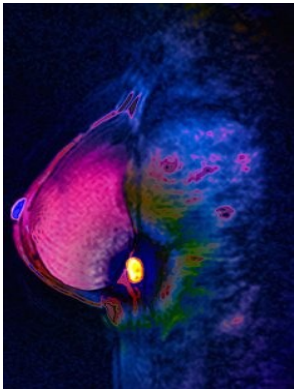




Breast MRI Study



If you are between 25 and 80 years of age, are a **healthy woman** or a woman who has been diagnosed with a **benign or malignant breast mass** that has not been treated, you may be eligible to participate in a breast MRI study.

If you choose to participate, you will partake in a 60-minute breast imaging procedure. No contrast dye will be used.

There is no fee to participate in the study. The study will pay for the entire 60 minute MRI/MRS exam. You will be paid \$75 for your participation in the study.

Your participation in this study is entirely voluntary and for research purposes only. The benefits to society include an enhanced understanding of the causes and the biochemistry of breast cancers. It is hoped that this investigation will result in a new technique to image benign and suspicious areas in the breast.
