Jesse Clark, MD, MSc is Professor in Residence in the Department of Medicine, Division of Infectious Disease and in the Department of Family Medicine at UCLA David Geffen School of Medicine. He serves as Medical Director for the UCLA Vine Street Clinic (UVSC) and Investigator of Record for multiple HIV Prevention Trials Network, HIV Vaccine Trials Network, Addiction Clinical Trials Network, and COVID Prevention Network studies conducted at UVSC. Outside of CBAM, he is Director of the UCLA South American Program in HIV Prevention Research (SAPHIR) training program. His research addresses the application of new HIV and STI prevention technologies through the social and sexual networks of sexual and gender minorities in the U.S. and Latin America. He received his medical degree from the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, completed residency at Montefiore Medical Center and was an infectious disease fellow at UCLA prior to joining the faculty.
