DESCRIPTION

On this rotation, fellows will participate in several different outpatient experiences and in inpatient wound rounds with the wound team.

GOALS

- 1. The fellow will learn to evaluate and treat female pelvic floor disorders.
- 2. The fellow will learn to evaluate and treat female urinary incontinence.
- 3. The fellow will learn the differential diagnosis, staging, evaluation and treatment of Parkinson's Disease and other movement disorders.
- 4. The fellow will develop competence in the evaluation and care of chronic non-surgical wounds.
- 5. The fellow will learn to diagnose and treat osteopenia and osteoporosis
- 6. The fellow will appreciate the interdisciplinary team approach in the prevention and treatment of falls
- 7. The fellow will learn how to assess the older adult with recurrent falls and appreciate the multifactorial causes that lead to falls
- 8. The fellow will identify age-related conditions that impact driving ability and increase knowledge on screening and assessing for driving safety by completing an online module
