



He continued his studies in data science while obtaining his MPH in health management.

During residency, Dr. Dong participated in the UCLA Resident Informaticist program and worked on projects such as evaluating ERAS protocols and geospatial visualizations. After graduating, he completed a fellowship in regional anesthesiology and acute pain medicine at the Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS), where he was the Informatics and Quality Assurance. He stayed on at HSS, where he served as the Assistant Director of Informatics, trained as an EPIC physician builder, and worked on various user optimization and clinical decision support projects.


