He has more recently developed an interest in clinical research, working as an investigator at the SCPMG Center for Vaccine Safety and Effectiveness Research and the CDC Vaccine Safety Datalink (VSD) research group. He is currently the principal investigator for a CDC VSD study on the safety of travel vaccines.
