Through the generous support of various donors, the CDI Fellows Research Support Award was established in 2016 to provide funding to support research projects of competitively selected UCLA pediatric scholars in their second or third years of training. The one-year research projects must be in a field relevant to pediatrics and may be in a basic, translational, clinical or health services area of research focused on promoting or improving children's health.
