

- Jamil Aboulhosn, M.D., co-authored interventional cardiology training guidelines for the American College of Cardiology that were published in February. He also edited and co-authored with Ariane J. Marelli, M.D., M.P.H., the 7th edition of Perloff's Clinical Recognition of Congenital Heart Disease. The Adult Congenital Heart Association presented Dr. Aboulhosn with the Amy Verstappen Leadership Award at its annual meeting for his commitment and achievements in the field of ACHD.
- Leigh Reardon, M.D., an international leader on LGBTQ issues, gave seminal talks at the 32nd Annual International Symposium on ACHD and at the American College of Cardiology's March 2023 Scientific Session. He has also been invited to talk on transgender health in cardiology at the 8th World Congress of Pediatric Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery.
- In recognition of her education leadership, Jeannette P. Lin, M.D., was asked to represent the field of ACHD on the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education.
- Gentian Lluri, M.D., Ph.D., led accreditation of the UCLA ACHD echocardiography program.
- Jeremy P. Moore, M.D., became chairperson of the Pediatric and Congenital Electrophysiology Society/International Society for Adult Congenital Heart Disease committee for electrophysiology research.
