Professor, UCSF Department of Family and Community Medicine

Dr. Gottlieb is a Professor in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at UCSF and the founding co-director of the Social Interventions Research and Evaluation Network, a national research network that advances research on health care strategies to improve social conditions. Dr. Gottlieb leads research examining the integration of social and medical care services. These projects range from large randomized trials on specific interventions undertaken in clinical settings to projects that explore the scope of this rapidly evolving field, including by characterizing the payment, technology, and workforce foundation for care integration. Dr. Gottlieb completed her MD at Harvard Medical School, and both her MPH and residency training at the University of Washington. She is the Associate Director of the UCSF Center for Health and Community and affiliate faculty in the UCSF Institute for Health Policy Studies.
