Hepatobiliary Pathology Grossing Guidelines

Specimen Type: CHOLECYSTECTOMY (NON-TUMOR)

Gross Template:

MMODAL COMMAND: "INSERT GALLBLADDER"

It consists of [an intact/previously incised, fragmented***] gallbladder measuring [measure in three dimensions***] cm. The attached portion of cystic duct measures [***] cm in length x [***] cm in diameter. The serosa is [pink-tan and smooth, describe any lesions].
