## **Ophthalmic Pathology Grossing Guidelines**

## Specimen Type: PTERYGIUM

- FOR ALL JS SPECIMENS LEAVE FORMALIN IN CONTAINER AND KEEP CONTAINER UNTIL AFTER SIGN OUT. DO NOT FILTER THESE SPECIMENS THROUGH A MESH BAG.
- Always ink the deep surface of these specimens.

# Gross Template:

## MMODAL Command: "INSERT PTERYGIUM"

It consists of a [*measure in three dimensions*<sup>\*\*\*</sup>] cm pink-tan soft tissue fragment. The specimen is entirely submitted, in a mesh bag, in cassette [*describe cassette submission*<sup>\*\*\*</sup>].

#### INK KEY:

Green resection margin

**Note**: deep surface is often the surface adherent to the cardboard & it may appear dull in comparison to the superficial surface

#### Cassette Submission: 1 cassette

o Submit entirely, unsectioned
