## **BONE AND SOFT TISSUE PATHOLOGY GROSSING GUIDELINES**

- NOTE: Document in your cassette summary which cassettes (for each specimen part) are submitted for decal
  - Ex: Representative sections are submitted (A1, A3; B2-B4; C3-C4 following decalcification).
  - Ex: Representative sections are submitted:
    - A1- bone (decal)
    - A2- skin resection margin, perpendicular
    - B2- tibia shave (decal)

## **MMODAL Command: "INSERT RIB"**

**Specimen Type: INCIDENTAL RIB** 

## **Gross Template**:

It consists of portions of bone ranging from [smallest to largest\*\*\*] cm in maximum dimension and measuring [measure in three dimensions\*\*\*] cm in aggregate. The bone is sectioned to reveal [describe cut surface/no abnormalities are identified/a gross abnormality is identified \*\*\*].
