 - 4. Please assign Christine Park as your default Request Approver by going to Profile > Request Settings > Request Approvers. You only need to do this once.

VIII. Proposals and Contracts/Grants

- a. Effort Reporting
 - 1. Due by July. Log in to ERS to review and submit.
 - 2. Effort Reporting Guide is available on our website
- b. Hyperlinks and URLs are not allowed anywhere in NIH proposals unless specifically allowed in the FOA.
 - 1. NOT-OD-20-174
 - 2. OCGA will ask you to remove them and the NIH may reject your proposal if you include them.

- 3. Typically the only allowable hyperlink would be in the biosketch, where you can link to your full list of publications (using My Bibliography only).
- 4. When allowed, NIH requests that the entire link appear in the text, e.g.:



5. Why?

- To prevent applicants from unfairly circumnavigating page/content restrictions (e.g. "Click here for a more detailed explanation of our research plan...")
- To maintain reviewer confidentiality (it is possible for tracking systems to allow an applicant to identify who accessed a website, thereby revealing a reviewer's identity)
- To ensure consistency amongst reviewers (if some reviewers considered supplemental infromation provided via hyperlink and others do not, the quality of review can be negatively impacted by inconsistency)
- To prevent malware attacks (reviewers may be at risk following links to non-NIH managed websites)


c. DocuSign


- 1. Required for a variety of research forms, including the new Other Support pages and PI Exceptions. Many departments (including OCGA) are now mandating that all documents be signed via DocuSign.
- 2. You must take the required DocuSign Sender Training in order to create new DocuSign documents. Log into Cornerstone and search for course "ELRSH902." The course is online, free, and takes approximately 45 minutes.
- 3. Once you have completed training, you will be able to access the <u>UCLA DocuSign</u> website and upload documents for signature.
- 4. If you want to sign a document yourself, click on the "Start" button and select "Sign a Document."




Then click on "Upload" and upload the document you want to sign (e.g. the Other Support page).

Once the document has uploaded, click "Sign."








The document will open and the system will ask you to review the document. Click "Continue." You can then drag and drop your signature, date, initials, etc. where needed on the form.

When you have finished adding your signature(s), click "Finish."



The system will then send you an email with a link to your completed/signed document. A window will also pop up, giving you the opportunity to directly send the signed document to anyone else you'd like.
