Password Compliance

1. ****REQUIRED**** Check compliance status:
<https://changepassword.mednet.ucla.edu/>
2. Change your password if it does not pass
3. If you need to change your password, your new password/passphrase must:
 - Be **at least 14 characters** in length.
 - Be rated **Strong/Very Strong** and not considered compromised.
 - Contain 3 of the following:
 - Number (0-9)
 - Lower case letter (a-z)
 - Upper case letter (A-Z)
 - Special characters (e.g. !#\$%^&*)

Important: In order to avoid lockouts after changing your password/passphrase, update credentials anywhere it may have been saved (e.g., browsers, mobile devices, wireless networks, apps, mac keychain).

If your password is not compliant with the new requirements, you will be scheduled for a forced reset in early 2023.

Increase in Meal Rates

Travel Meals

- The Meal and Incidental Expenses (M&IE) Reimbursement Cap is the maximum amount authorized for the daily meal and incidental expenses established by the University.
- Applies to any business travel of less than 30 days in the continental United States
- The maximum M&IE rate for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 is **\$79.00** and is based on the highest per diem rate available for all UC locations as published by US General Services Administration for Fiscal 2023.

Increase in Meal Rates

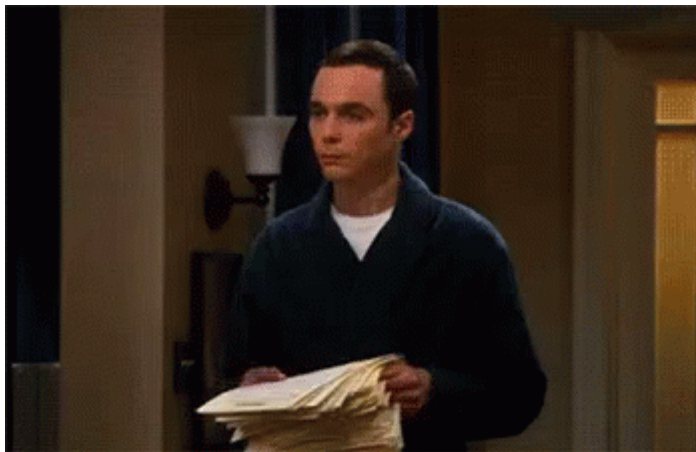
Entertainment Meals

- The maximum meal rates for entertainment and business meeting meals have been increased in response to soaring food prices.
- The new rates are as follows:
 - Breakfast \$31
 - Lunch \$54
 - Dinner \$94
 - Light Refreshments \$22
- As a reminder, these amounts include the cost of food and beverages, labor, sales tax, service, and delivery charges

Concur/Travel Express

New system was supposed to make it easier for travelers to create their own reimbursement reports



Travel Reimbursements

Submit Form Like the Old Days

- Save your receipts
- Complete Travel Reimbursement Form
- Obtain PI or Approver approval
- Submit to Fund Manager
- Valencia will submit via Concur/Travel Express, will contact you when done
- TRAVELLER MUST THEN “SUBMIT” REPORT IN CONCUR
- NOTE: Guests do not need to register for PaymentWorks

New NIH Data Management and Sharing Policy

To encourage the management and sharing of scientific data produced by NIH-funded or carried out research

- Effective Date is January 25, 2023 for all submitted proposals
 - Requires submission of a plan outlining how scientific data and any accompanying metadata will be managed and shared, taking into account any potential restrictions or limitations.
 - The NIH may request additional information to be included within the Plan in order to meet expectations for data management and data sharing
 - We have to include such a plan on all proposals and we have to comply with the plan once it is approved and awarded

New NIH Forms H

- Due for applications due on/after Jan 25, 2023
- Requires Data Management and Sharing Plan (next slide)
- Budget: must include DMSP costs as an individual line item with justification




