They will be shadowing rounds daily (Monday through Sunday) starting on 1/17/23 from 7:45 am through ~ 11 am. The goal of this program is to increase exposure for bright individuals to help attract them to a career in medicine! Please review the following "Do's" & "Don'ts" for additional logistics.

Do's:

- Introduce every member of your team when visiting a patient including your student observer
- Bring the student to see new admits or interesting patients after sit-rounds. Or with you on walk-rounds.
- Engage with the student observers to ask if they have questions during breaks or at the end of rounds
- Discuss about your life in medicine as they are trying to figure out if they want to pursue a field in medicine
- Contact the chief on pager if there are any issues or concerns

Don'ts:

- Student observers are not allowed to see patients with confirmed or suspected COVID
- · Student observers are not allowed to enter patient rooms that are require isolation gowns
- Student observers are not allowed to access the medical record directly or directly contribute to patient care
- Remember, these undergraduate students are SHADOWING, that means they are not allowed to directly provide patient care
