UCLA Research Study for Children and Adolescents with Crohn's Disease

Children and Adolescents 16 years of age and under with Crohn's disease may be eligible to participate in a Research Study to identify "bio-markers"

"Bio-markers" are found in blood, stool, or lining in the intestine.

The study involves coming to UCLA for 4 visits over a period of 3 years.

Procedures include:

- Venipuncture (Drawing Blood)
- Stool Collection (only during the screening visit)
- Mucosal Biopsy Collection (optional sub-study)

All procedures are performed during the patient's regularly scheduled doctor's appointment.
