Common asthma triggers

- Cigarette Smoke
- Dust Mites
- Mold
- Respiratory Tract Infection
- Cockroaches
- Air Pollution
- Animal Dander



Common asthma symptoms

- Wheezing
- Shortness of Breath
- Chest Tightness
- Labored Breathing
- Low Energy
- Poor Feeding
