- Ex: Representative sections are submitted (A1, A3; B2-B4; C3-C4 following decalcification).
- Ex: Representative sections are submitted:
 - A1- bone (decal)
 - A2- skin resection margin, perpendicular
 - B2- tibia shave (decal)

Specimen Type: Revision Surgery of Orthopedic Implants

Gross Template Sample--KNEE:

Labeled with the patient's name (***), medical record number (***), designated "***", and received [fresh/in formalin] are three pieces of orthopedic hardware. The first piece consists of a black-gray distal femoral component which measures 4.5 x 4.6 x 5.7 cm. The inner surface contains red-white hard and irregular cement-like material. The second piece consists of a white smooth polyethylene spacer is present measuring 6.2 x 4.0 x 1.6 cm. An inscription is present that reads as follows: "***". The third piece consists of a silver metallic tibial component is present measuring 6.3 x 6.0 x 4.5 cm. An inscription is present that reads as follows: "***". A red-white, irregularly shaped fragment of bone cement is present measuring 2 x 1 x 0.5 cm. No soft tissue is present. The specimen is for gross examination only. A gross photograph is taken.

Gross Template Sample--HIP:

Labeled with the patient's name (***), medical record number (***), designated "***", and received [fresh/in formalin] are two pieces of orthopedic hardware. The first piece is a silver metallic smooth to rough, angled rod-like device measuring 15.2 x 5.7 x 1.6 cm. There is a hole at the superior aspect of the piece, measuring 1.0 cm in diameter. An inscription is present that reads as follows: "***". There is a white polyethylene, smooth dome measuring 4.2 cm in diameter x 3.4 cm in height. In the center of the dome is a rotating white plastic appearing ball measuring 2.5 cm in diameter. A hole is present in the center of the rotating ball measuring 1.3 cm in diameter. An inscription is present that reads as follows: "***". No soft tissue is present. The specimen is for gross examination only. A gross photograph is taken.

Cassette Submission: 4 cassettes

- 3 sections of joint capsule/soft tissue (focus on synovial surface)
- 1 section of bone, if present
