Specimen Type: THYMECTOMY

Gross Template:

Labeled with the patient's name (last name, first name), medical record number (#), designated "***", and received [fresh/in formalin] is a ***gram, *** x *** x *** cm [partial/total] thymectomy. [Describe orientation if provided]. Sectioning reveals [describe any lesions present including size, color, external appearance, relationship to capsule, calcification, necrosis, relationship to uninvolved thymus]. Cassette Submission: 10-12 cassettes

- One cassette if incidentally removed
- One cassette per 1 cm of lesion/tumor
 - Show relationship to capsule
 - Show relationship to unremarkable parenchyma
- One cassette of unremarkable parenchyma
- Submit all lymph nodes identified
- Submit representative sections of other structures present (pleura, pericardium, etc.)
