CARDIOVASCULAR PATHOLOGY GROSSING GUIDELINES

<u>NOTE:</u> Please review all complex or "interesting" gross specimens with Drs. Michael Fishbein, Gregory Fishbein, or Ryan Lau.

Specimen Type: VENTRICULAR ASSIST DEVICES

PROCEDURE: Review all ventricular assist devices with Dr. G Fishbein.

Gross Template:

Labeled with the patient's name (***), medical record number (***), designated "***", and received [fresh/in formalin] is a [type] ventricular assist device with the serial number "***". The inflow cannula is free of thrombi [if not, describe location and size]. [If an inflow valve is present, describe]. There is no in-pump thrombus [if thrombus present, describe location and size].
