

Please remember: Visitors must remain masked at all times.

If you've tested positive for COVID-19, please postpone any patient visitation until 10 days have passed.

If you are experiencing cough, cold or any symptoms of flu or COVID-19, please stay home.

We strongly recommend that all visitors are vaccinated and have received the boosters for which they are eligible.

Patient Population	Visitors/Hours/Duration	Notes
Adult patients (including shared rooms)	2 healthy visitors at a time.	All visitors must: -Be flu and COVID symptom-free -Check in for badging -Wear a mask at all times Additional visitors at bedside for near death will be considered. Consult unit leadership
Labor and Delivery patients	2 healthy visitors at a time, one of which may be a doula.	Visitation for siblings may be arranged on a case-by-case basis.
Pediatric patients	2 healthy visitors.	Visitation for siblings may be arranged on a case-by-case basis.
NICU Babies Ronald Reagan Santa Monica	2 healthy parents, guardians, grandparents or designated visitors at a time.	Parents may identify up to 4 designated visitors. For details, speak with your NICU nurse. Visitors may be asked to step out if the department becomes overcrowded. Visitation for siblings may be arranged on a case-by-case basis.
COVID-19 POSITIVE patients	No visitors at this time. Virtual visits are available.	

<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE Near death patients</p>	<p>2 healthy visitors allowed for a 2-hour visit.</p>	<p>Imminent death determined by clinical team during scheduled clinical meetings for goals of care discussions.</p>
<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE Pediatric patients</p>	<p>1 healthy parent/guardian at a time.</p>	<p>Parent must stay in room for duration of stay.</p>
<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE Labor and Delivery patients</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor.</p>	<p>Visitor must stay in room for duration of stay. Operating room entry is restricted due to significant space limitations.</p>
<p>Resnick Neuropsychiatric Hospital patients</p>	<p>RNPH is permitting two healthy visitors per patient, during each visiting period. Visitation cannot be split or shared between multiple visitors. Telephone calls remain available for those unable to visit in person.</p> <p>Unit specific visitation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4E: Mon – Fri: 5:30 pm – 6:30 pm; Sat – Sun and holidays: 2 – 4 pm and 5:30 – 6:30 pm • 4N: Mon – Fri: 5 pm – 6 pm; Sat – Sun and holidays: 4 – 6 pm • 4W: Mon – Fri: 6 pm – 7 pm; Sat – Sun and holidays: 2 – 4 pm and 6 - 7 pm 	<p>If patients are in a semi-private room, one patient will have their visitor during regular unit visiting hours and the other patient will have their visitor during the subsequent hour, to be arranged by unit staff.</p> <p>Visitation outside of the established visiting hours are permitted at the discretion of the primary team and staff, and should be communicated to the Front Desk Hospitality/Security staff by emailing visitormanagement@mednet.ucla.edu, or calling extension 79120.</p> <p>Visitors must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in the patient’s room while in the unit -Maintain 6 feet of physical distance in all areas, including the patient’s room -Wear a face mask at all times (provided)
<p>Same Day Surgery patients</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time.</p>	<p>Visitor will be assigned to a designated waiting room.</p>

<p>Emergency Departments</p> <p>Ronald Reagan and Santa Monica Medical Centers</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time.</p> <p>Pediatric patients: 2 healthy visitors/guardians at a time.</p> <p>Visitors may be asked to leave if the department becomes overcrowded.</p>	<p>Visitors must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be flu/COVID symptom- free -Check in with ED security badge -Wear a mask at all times -Stay in the patient's room <p>Visitors with patients slated for admission must check in at the main lobby information desk to receive a visitor badge prior to going to the patient room.</p>
<p>Ambulatory clinic patients</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time.</p>	<p>2 healthy parents/guardians allowed for pediatric visits.</p>
<p>Infusion area patients</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time.</p>	<p>2 healthy parents/guardians allowed for pediatric visits.</p>
