<p>Adult patients (no COVID-19) including semi-private rooms</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time. Must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	
<p>Adult patients – Near death (no COVID-19),</p>	<p>2 healthy visitors at a time</p>	<p>Imminent death determined by clinical team during scheduled clinical meetings for goals of care discussions</p>
<p>Labor and Delivery patients (no COVID-19)</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time. Must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	<p>1 healthy doula for labor and delivery only. Must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>
<p>Pediatric patients (no COVID-19)</p>	<p>2 healthy parents/guardians at a time. Must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	

<p>Adult Oncology - Bone Marrow Transplant and CAR T-cell Program</p> <p>(Santa Monica 4SW and AMN; Ronald Reagan 6East)</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time who must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	<p>No children under 12 allowed</p>
<p>NICU Babies</p> <p>Santa Monica</p>	<p>2 healthy parents/guardians at a time, who must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	
<p>NICU Babies</p> <p>Ronald Reagan</p>	<p>1 healthy parent/guardian at a time, who must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for PCR or 1 day if using antigen test</p>	<p>Due to significant space limitations: 2 healthy parents/guardians allowed at a time under certain conditions</p>
<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE patients</p>	<p>No visitors at this time. Virtual visits are available</p>	<p>Exception for imminent death, determined during scheduled clinical meetings for goals of care discussions</p>
<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE patients - Near death</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor allowed for a 2-hour visit</p>	<p>Imminent death determined by clinical team during scheduled clinical meetings for goals of care discussions</p>
<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE Pediatric patients</p>	<p>1 healthy parent/guardian at a time, who must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	<p>Parent must stay in room for duration of stay</p>

<p>COVID-19 POSITIVE Labor and Delivery patients</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor. Must be either fully vaccinated and have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	<p>Visitor must stay in room for duration of stay. Operating room entry is restricted due to significant space limitations.</p>
<p>Resnick Neuropsychiatric Hospital patients</p>	<p>No visitors at this time.</p>	<p>Exceptions are made on a case-by-case basis to facilitate admission and discharge.</p>
<p>Same Day Surgery patients</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time. Must be either fully vaccinated or have proof of a negative test result within 2 days for a PCR test or 1 day for an antigen test</p>	<p>Visitor will be assigned to a designated waiting room</p>
<p>Emergency Department Ronald Reagan</p>	<p>No visitors at this time.</p> <p>Exceptions include: -Pediatric patients -Labor & Delivery patients -Patients with disabilities/cognitive impairment -Patients near end of life</p> <p>All exceptions will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis</p>	<p>Visitors allowed because of exception must: -Be flu/COVID symptom-free -Check in with ED security badge -Wear a mask at all times -Stay in the patient's room</p> <p>If a visitor is waiting for an ED patient to be admitted, they must wait outside the ED, and will only be allowed to visit once admitted patient tests negative for COVID-19.</p>
<p>Emergency Department Santa Monica</p>	<p>1 healthy visitor at a time Pediatric patients: 2 caregivers allowed at bedside All exceptions will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis</p>	<p>Visitors must: -Be flu/COVID symptom free -Check in with ED security-badge -Wear a mask at all times -Stay in the patient's room</p>

		If a visitor is waiting for an ED patient to be admitted, they must wait outside the ED, and will only be allowed to visit once admitted patient tests negative for COVID-19.
Ambulatory clinic patients	1 healthy visitor who is participating in the visit	2 healthy parents/guardians allowed for pediatric visits
Infusion area patients	1 healthy caregiver is allowed with patients who have specific care needs	2 healthy parents/guardians allowed for pediatric visits
