To proceed with a referral, we require the following information to be faxed to 424-483-5850:

- Patient's face sheet and demographics
- Caregivers contact information, if applicable
- Insurance information (for outside referrals, the ADC Program is accepting patients with Medicare Part A&B primary insurance only)
- Documentation confirming the diagnosis

Please inform your patient they will need to create a UCLA Health patient profile before proceeding with scheduling an initial appointment. Please call 310-319-3222 and create the profile with a Patient Communication Representative.
