Program Description

The Visiting Student Scholarship Program (VSSP) is intended to provide financial support to any visiting fourth-year U.S. medical student interested in completing UCLA Anesthesiology Elective AN450.01, especially those with an interest in improving health equality.

Eligibility

All U.S. 4th year medical students with a commitment to fostering workforce diversity in healthcare professions are encouraged to apply, especially those coming from groups that are underrepresented in medicine (UIM) from a social, economic, or educational perspective, including first-generation college graduates, and those from rural or lower economic demographics.

All students must also meet the following criteria:

- 4th year medical student in good academic standing at an accredited U.S. medical school
- Completed core clerkships in internal medicine, obstetrics/gynecology, pediatrics, psychiatry, and surgery
- Passed USMLE Step 1 prior to rotation

Application Process

The following materials are required at least 45 days prior to the desired rotation's start date, but preferably prior to May 1st:

• VSSP Application Form

- This includes a Statement of Interest that speaks to your interests and the importance of improving health equity as well as the applicant's specific interest in the UCLA DAPM Residency Program.
- UCLA DGSOM Visiting Student Application, using VSLO elective listing AN450.01: Anesthesiology sub-internship at UCLA/Santa Monica. This must include:
 - One letter of recommendation from a faculty member
 - An official academic transcript
 - A recent CV

<u>Program Timeline</u>

- AN450.01 application becomes available on VSLO in March annually.
- AN450.01 is available June-December annually.
- Scholarship recipients will be selected by the VSSP committee on a rolling basis starting May 1st.
- Applicants are encouraged to apply by May 1st to maximize their likelihood of consideration for the scholarship.
