## **MMODAL COMMAND: INSERT I V C FILTER**

The specimen is received unfixed, labeled with patient's name ([last name, first name\*\*\*]), medical record number ([insert MRN\*\*\*]), and designated as "[Dictate full description listed in Beaker. Ensure that the specimen label matches the Beaker order\*\*\*]". It consists of a [\*\*\*] cm in length x [\*\*\*] cm in diameter inferior vena cava (IVC) filter.
