- 2. Enter your medical record number, select the year you were born, and enter initials to verify who you are.
- **3.** Watch the U Consent video and confirm you have watched the video.
- **4.** Then, tell us your preference on whether UCLA Health can use your leftover biological samples for research and how you want to participate.
