CNRC Enrollment and Biobanking:

Investigators can utilize CNRC's universal IRB and HIPAA consent to build cohorts of interest, including studies of unique populations, rare disorders, or common disease in their patients. Integrate it directly into your existing study IRB. CNRC staff can consent patients, collect DNA and other unique biospecimens for your study. The biobank already includes thousands of DNA and RNA samples, and hundreds of plasma and serum samples, as well as specialty collections of CSF, fibroblasts, tissue biopsies, urine, PBMCs, cell-free DNA or RNA, and others. Additional samples types may be available on request.
