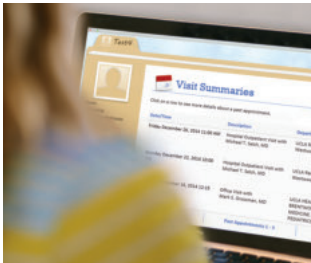


## New feature offered on myUCLAhealth



Beginning April 2, 2015, patients who are seen at one of the UCLA Health Santa Monica Bay Physicians' offices and who are signed up for **myUCLAhealth**,

will be able to view most visit notes completed by the UCLA Health Santa Monica Bay Physician providers. Visit notes completed by a physician, nurse practitioner or physician assistant may not appear in **myUCLAhealth** until a few days after your appointment. At this time, notes that are written outside the clinics of Santa Monica Bay Physician providers and notes for patients aged 12-17 years will not be available in **myUCLAhealth**.

### How providers use visit notes to document your healthcare

Providers on your care team typically will write at least one note for every office visit. These notes are a professional summary of the visit as part of your medical record. Our goal is to provide you access to these notes in **myUCLAhealth** so that you have additional information about your medical conditions and become a partner with us in our mission to improve your health.
