

Schedule COVID-19 Vaccine in MyChart / myUCLAhealth


Patients invited to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at a UCLA Health site can self-schedule that appointment within their active myUCLAhealth account.

- The COVID-19 vaccines require <u>TWO</u> doses. After receiving the first dose, you will be able to schedule your booster shot.

SCHEDULE FIRST DOSE

Login to <u>my.UCLAhealth.org</u>. You will be brought to the Schedule an Appointment screen. If you're not redirected, click **Visits > Schedule an Appointment**.

1. Click **Schedule Now** in the COVID-19 Vaccine tile.



2. **REQUIRED**: Type your **name**.











Choose an available date and time.



SCHEDULE SECOND DOSE


- 1. Login to my.UCLAhealth.org.
- Choose Make an appointment. We have sent you a new scheduling ticket or click Visits > Schedule an Appointment.
- 3. You will see a COVID-19 DOSE 2 tile. Click Schedule Now and follow steps 3 through 6 above.



SCHEDULE THROUGH MYCHART MOBILE

You can use the MyChart app to schedule your COVID vaccine appointments.

- 1. Tap on Appointments > Schedule an appointment.
- 2. Schedule Now.
- 3. **REQUIRED**: Enter your **name**.
- 4. Select a location.
- 5. Choose a date and time.
- 6. **REQUIRED**: Enter a reason for visit. Tap **Schedule**.





